Ongoing Tasks:

- Sort bead jewelry by style and color
 - Put on rings in groups of 20-25
 - Put rings into labeled ziplock bags and then into storage bins
- Tag and price beads, scarves, handbags, sewn products and baskets.
 - These are made available on the online store and at various events.
- Sort and organize new products as they arrive
- Take loose beads and restring into necklaces, earrings, bracelets, etc.
